E2A Community of Practice Meeting on Scale-up

USAID ASSIST's Dr. M. Rashad Massoud and Dr. Maina Boucar presented at the [Community of Practice meeting on Scale-up](#) [1] convened by the Evidence to Action (E2A) Project on December 5 in Washington, DC. Ms. Rhea Bright presented on behalf of Dr. James Heiby of USAID to give USAID's perspectives on scale-up. Dr. Massoud framed the issues with his presentation, "How Can We Scale Up Successful Interventions". Dr. Maina Boucar then presented the case of how practices and strategies to improvement essential obstetric and newborn care that had been successfully applied in Niger were then applied in Mali, obtaining similar results but in a shorter time period, due to the deliberate spread strategy to operationalize practices proven in Niger in Mali, which has a similar health care setting.
