## A Finer Cut: South Africa's Journey to Improve Quality in Voluntary Medical Male Circumcision

This short film describes the support provided by the PEPFAR-funded USAID Applying Science to Strengthen and Improve Systems (ASSIST) Project to introduce continuous quality improvement (CQI) in PEPFAR-supported voluntary medical male circumcision (VMMC) services in South Africa. It includes short interview with various implementers—Provincial Department of Health, implementing partners, private sector, and QI coaches—who talk about what they have learned about improving and sustaining quality of VMMC services.
