VIDEO: Cost-effectiveness of an intervention to increase immunization coverage in Pakistan

This is a presentation of the results of a cost-effectiveness study to improve immunization uptake among children under 2 years of age and pregnant women in Sindh province in Pakistan.

The [study](#) [1] was commissioned by the health office at the USAID Mission in Pakistan and sought to address three (3) main questions with respect to this program:

1. What was the cost-effectiveness of this program to improve vaccination among children under 2 and pregnant women in four low-coverage districts in Sindh (Jacobabad, Kashmore, Tharparkar, and Thatta) from a USAID perspective?
2. What is the estimated cost-effectiveness of the program if it had been implemented by the Government of Sindh Department of Health (GOSDOH)?
3. Would the program be sustainable?
